2018 Beckstoffer To Kalon Cabernet Sauvignon | \$625/3Pack | Jeb Dunnuck 98

The 2018 Beckstoffer To Kalon may be the super star in the Boich Family 2018 line up. A big dense purple color is followed by awesome notes of blueberry liqueur, spring flowers, incense, tobacco leaf and graphite. With full-bodied richness, sweet tannins and flawlessly integrated oak and that rare mix of opulence and elegance. This brilliant Oakville Cabernet can be drunk over the coming 25-30 years.

2018 Beckstoffer Vineyard Georges III Cabernet Sauvignon | \$525/3Pack | Jeb Dunnuck 95+

The 2018 Georges III vineyard is another more than noteworthy wine in the Boich Family line up. Lots of classic Cabernet notes of darker currants, damp earth, chocolate, and tobacco notes give way to a full-bodied wine that has lot of richness and depth while staying nicely balanced and light on its feet. It builds nicely with time in the glass, and while not a true blockbuster, it shines for its classic character and overall balance. It's beautifully done and is going to evolve for 20-25 years.

2018 Beckstoffer Missouri Hopper Cabernet Sauvignon | \$525/3Pack | Jeb Dunnuck 96

The 2018 Missouri Hopper brings more exuberance and up-front character, offering beautiful notes of red and black currants, blueberries, spring flowers, toasty oak, violet, and incense-like aromas and flavors. Playing in the medium to full-bodied end of the spectrum, this pure, elegant, balanced 2018 shows the vintage's style to a T and has polished tannins as well as a great finish, It can be drunk today with incredible pleasure or cellared for 15-20 years if you are so inclined.

2018 Wall Road Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon Cabernet | \$525/3Pack | Jeb Dunnuck 95

The 2018 Wall Road Vineyard is a more structured wine which is normal for wines from the Mount Veeder AVA, a cooler, mountainous terroir. Giving up lots of red and black fruits intermixed with notes of scrub brush, tobacco, crushed rock, and freshly sharpened lead pencils, this beauty hits the palate with medium to full-bodied richness, some chalky tannins, terrific depth of fruit, and the concentration, structure, and balance to improve over the coming 4-5 years and keep for two decades.
