Perennius – Crafted from the best barrel selections of our portfolio, Perennius captures the greatest qualities of our 2018 Cabernet Sauvignon wines.

Napa Valley AVA – One of the world's premier wine regions, Napa Valley brings the ideal combination of Mediterranean climate, geography and geology, providing excellent consistency vintage-to-vintage. Flanked by the Mayacamas and Vaca Mountain ranges, distinct microclimates and terrains can be found throughout the valley, allowing for a wide range of world-class grape varieties with distinct, recognizable qualities.

Vintage Notes – 2018 saw bud break, flowering and harvest later than normal. A mild summer with no noteworthy heat spikes meant generous sunny days and cooler marine influences. Extended fall sunshine created ideal conditions and allowed for extended hangtime as the grapes developed amazing phenolics and flavors. This vintage will likely be rated among the best in the past 20 years.

It really shows how blending and selection can shape a wine, as while it shares the dark fruit shown by the single-vineyard bottlings, it takes the mocha, cassis, plum and black cherry notes and raises the bar even higher, adding impressive length and freshness. Full-bodied, lush, fruit-driven, rich, and enormously complex, this is really terrific stuff and nearly worthy of a perfect score.

International Wine Report, 99 | The 2018 'Perennius' Cabernet Sauvignon is drop dead gorgeous. This seductive wine begins with incredibly perfumed aromas of ripe blackberries, blueberries and dark currents, which are accented by nuances of cigar box, sweet spices, violets, loam and hints of fresh sage nuances which all burst from the glass. On the palate this is full-bodied, layered and remarkably concentrated, with impressive depth. There is a wonderful display of balance as the deep, intense fruit character is underlined by lovely acidity, which adds a gorgeous sense of freshness. This goes on to impress with its outstanding structure and beautifully polished frame that persists through the long multi-dimensional finish. The 2018 Perennius is simply amazing and nothing short of utterly delicious at this early stage, however it also has the stuff to cruise in the cellar for decades.
