Flanked by the Mayacamas and Vaca Mountain ranges, distinct microclimates and terrains can be found throughout the valley, allowing for a wide range of world-class grape varieties.

Vintage Notes | An exceptional vintage, the 2019 growing season was marked by a wet spring followed by a long summer with few extreme heat events. Consistent temperatures helped to preserve the freshness in the fruit while allowing abundant hang time – resulting in concentrated clusters with beautiful color, structure, soft tannins, and bright acidity. These wines will age beautifully for years to come.

Accolades

Jeb Dunnuck, 93 points | The 2019 Cabernet Sauvignon NVS is rock solid and, as far as Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon goes, a terrific value. Giving up a juicy Cabernet nose of darker fruits, cassis, chocolate, tobacco, and just a hint of flowers, it's medium to full-bodied, has ripe tannins, and a forward, undeniably delicious style perfect for drinking over the coming decade. There are just 375 cases made.

International Wine Report, 93 points | The 2019 Napa Valley 'NVS' offers inviting aromas of dark/red currants and plums which are woven together with graphite, cocoa powder, tobacco, wet stones and hints of fresh cut floral which all take shape. On the palate this possesses a medium-full body that is structured with nicely polished tannins making for a gorgeous mouthfeel. It continues to impress with its seamless texture and lovely finesse through the finish. A wonderful Cabernet that is accessible early on yet should also have a drinking window that spans at least a decade.
